

CALLING FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FROM ABORIGINAL ARTISTS OR DESIGNERS

Who we are:

The Aboriginal Health and Medical Research Council (AH&MRC) of NSW is the peak representative body and voice of Aboriginal communities on health in NSW. Our Membership is comprised of the Aboriginal Community Controlled Health and Health Related Services that deliver culturally appropriate comprehensive primary health care to their communities.

Artwork Concept:

The aim of the artwork is to provide visual representation of hearing health within NSW for children between the ages of 0-4 years old.

The selected artwork will be used for promotional material, resources and uniforms for the AH&MRC Ear and Hearing Coordination Program. The Ear and Hearing Coordination Program has been created in partnership with the Rural Doctors Network.

Key themes that could be potentially be explored in the artwork are:

We are seeking an artwork that will explore the concept of hearing health while reflecting the core business of AH&MRC; supporting Member Services to improve the health and wellbeing of Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander People living in NSW.

The artwork requires the incorporation of the AH&MRC colour palette (see attachment). How the colours are used remains up to the discretion of the artist.

Submitting an EOI:

Artists and designers should submit concept designs on an A3 sized piece of paper or as an email attachment. The design should be accompanied by a supporting statement/story describing the artwork as part of the EOI. Individual and collaborative artworks are accepted, as are contemporary and/or traditional art forms.

Submissions of the EOI close on **Friday the 15th of May 2020**.

Successful Submission:

The successful artist, selected based on the suitability of their artwork, will receive \$3,000 GST inclusive for their work (\$1,000 payable to the artist on acceptance of the design and \$2,000 payable to the artist upon delivery of the final artwork).

[Please note: The successful artwork, for which the stated fee is paid, will be the property of the AH&MRC. As owners of the copyright of the successful artwork, the AH&MRC will use the artwork, or part thereof, for promotional activities as required.]

Terms and Conditions in Relation to the Commissioned Artwork:

- The value of the fee/commission to the successful applicant is \$3,000 (GST incl.) as per the agreed contract on the following schedule: \$1,000 payable to the artist upon acceptance of the design; and \$2,000 payable to the artist upon delivery of the final artwork.
- The project will require the artist to sign a contract outlining the approved use of the artwork.
- The legal title to the artwork (ownership) will be vested to the AH&MRC upon the signing of the contract.
- AH&MRC will permit the artist to use the artwork for their own personal business activities including: promotion of their artistic works and style, use on their websites and social media as an example of their work but not as part of their website/logo design.
- The artist agrees that the artwork will not be reproduced, sold or used by any other entity.
- AH&MRC will have the right in perpetuity to use and reproduce the artwork and/or a portion of the artwork in its promotional activities and materials.
- The artist will be formally recognised as the artist of the artwork (where practicable).
- AH&MRC will have worldwide rights to use the artwork across all media
- AH&MRC will have the right to edit and modify the artwork for reproduction purposes.
- No further or ongoing payment will be made by AH&MRC to the artist other than the commission fee payment.
- The artist, upon signing the contract, will accept the Terms and Conditions of the commissioning and future use of the artwork by AH&MRC.
- AH&MRC at its discretion may stop using the artwork at any time.

Unsuccessful EOIs submitted:

- The EOIs can either be collected in person within one month of the successful EOI being selected or delivered to a contact address by Australia Post.
- The postage cost for return will be at AH&MRC's expense.
- While AH&MRC will take all care in relation to the safekeeping of the submitted artwork no responsibility will be accepted in the event of loss or damage.
